

Course Selection Planning Sheet for Junior Year

- Graduation requirements: 26 credits required
 - English (4.0), Math(3.0), Science (2.0), World History (1.0), Econ (0.5), Govt. (0.5), US History (1.0), Health (0.5), PE (3.5), Driver Ed (0.5), Strand 1(1.0), Strand 2 (1.0), Strand 3 (1.0)
 - Junior Requirements are English, PE, US History, Math and a Science class is highly encouraged and required for college
- Juniors must be scheduled for a minimum of 7.0 credits
- Choose electives based on your current career interests and college plans
- ASP – optional for juniors
- Late Arrival/Early Release – Juniors can take one period off ONLY if you are on track with graduation requirements and meet the required unweighted GPA of 2.5 or above and have parent approval
- Special Programs: D300 Internship (See your counselor for specific details and requirements)
- **ALL ELECTIVE CHOICES MUST BE ENTERED IN IC BY THE STUDENT – November 14th – November 25th, 2016**
 - Sophomores will be able to go to computer labs on **November 17 during their ASP** classes to enter electives in IC.
 - Appointments will be scheduled to meet with counselors in January and February.

STUDENT PORTAL MYAP
REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

2017-2018

In MYAP start planning your course requests. Nothing will be finalized until you meet with your counselor. Begin by following the directions below:

1. Log into Student Portal
 - User Name: Your student ID number
 - Password: Whatever password you created
2. Click on "Academic Planner"
You must complete this information only once
 - Post Grad Location
 - Post Grad Plans
3. Enter in classes for next year by clicking in the empty box in each group (English, Math, Science, etc)
 - When you click on the empty box, you will see courses recommended by your current teacher. *(You may not delete your teacher's recommendations, but you may add another choice and then discuss with your counselor when you meet)*

**Note: An alert will appear until you have all of your required credits planned.*

- *You can add courses by searching your schools course catalog "search the course catalog". (top right side of the page)*
- *When you find the course you want, click the grade in which you want this course to be entered. Example: Add to Grade 10 or Add to Grade 11 or Add to Grade 12*

***Note: When you choose a 2 semester course, the second semester is scheduled with it automatically even though it may not appear on the screen.*

****Note: If you meet the core course requirement (i.e. 2 years of science), the course will also show as a strand requirement (i.e. Human Anatomy and Physiology will show up in science and Strand 2). If you need to delete the course, delete it in the core section only and it will disappear in the Strand 2 section automatically.*

4. When finished adding classes to your Academic Planner
 - Click the "save" button next to the words Academic Planner*After you save, you can come back to add or delete classes at a later time.*

Final Notes to Remember:

- ✓ *Your MYAP will be open in your Student Portal from November 14 – November 25 for you to work on your plan.*
- ✓ *Remember this is just a plan of your requests and nothing is finalized until you meet with your counselor.*
- ✓ *Also, once the 2017-2018 school years starts, your MYAP account will be open again for you to make changes to your 2018-2019 plan and beyond.*
